What is changing and how will it affect me?

From **Ist JULY** there will be some changes to how the Pinpoint service works that you need to know about.

When you place a bid for a property you are interested in, you will now be put into a list for that property in a different way.

The partner you are registered with will have made an assessment

of your housing situation and need to move. This means whether or not you qualify for some kind of priority for housing.

You will be placed into one of the Pinpoint Bands based on this assessment.

The Pinpoint Bands are

Band A High Level of Need

Band B Some level of Need

Band C Low level of Need

When you Log In to Pinpoint you will be able to see which Pinpoint Band you are in.

Applicants placed in Band A will be highest on a shortlist for a property they bid on, then Band B, then Band C.

There will be properties which do not have any applicants from Band A and therefore Band B will be placed highest.

If no applicants from either Band A or B, Band C becomes highest
